



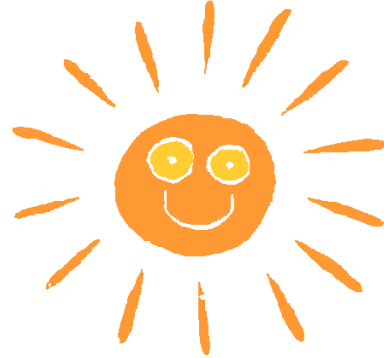

## Summer Fun Awaits Your Child

Brookwood's SummerCare program offers children a variety of exciting activities in a creative environment. Caring, well-trained staff direct a variety of traditional day camp activities such as arts and crafts, cookouts, group games, plenty of outdoor time, optional field trips, nature hikes, and an optional sleepover. Our spacious playgrounds and 23-acre campus provide an awesome opportunity to explore nature, learn new skills, and build lasting friendships.

## Theme Weeks

Each week features a new theme to focus and guide our activities and may include field trips, group projects, food preparation, instruction, or live performances. Themes may be modified for younger campers or as needed.

## Flexible Enrollment

Our program is designed for all families to use as much or as little as needed. We are open M-F, 6:30 a.m. - 5:30 p.m. We are closed July 4<sup>th</sup>.

# SummerCare Fees

## Registration Fee non-refundable

Sign up before May 16<sup>th</sup> and pay a reduced registration fee of \$30 per child for full summer registration.

**(After May 16<sup>th</sup> this fee goes up to \$45)**

\$5 per session for registrations less than 6 weeks.

Included in each registration are daily snacks, and a t-shirt to be worn on all field trips.

## Hourly Rates

Hourly rate is \$6.50. This rate is reduced to \$5.25 for all hours when the total hours used exceeds 25 hours per week.\*



*\*10% sibling discount. 15% for three or more full time campers, or 10% discount for Bassett employees on payroll deduction plan. Only one discount may be applied per child.*

## Childcare Subsidies

Brookwood is a licensed childcare center and accepts payments from the Department of Social Services for qualified families.

**After your registration is received, required additional forms will be sent to you. These MUST be returned prior to the start of SummerCare.**

# Theme Weeks

## Art Expo

June 27-July 1
